Asian-inspired starters served in the Zwipi Underground

1<sup>st</sup> Starter: Cape Malay Soup

2<sup>nd</sup> Starter: Chinese Beef Dumpling

7:50pm

Guests gather in the Scatterlings Restaurant for storytelling: Johannesburg's Asian communities during the Gold Rush and later (Cape Malay, Indian and Chinese).

8:10pm

Guests walk outside onto Gandhi Square to view the Gandhi sculpture and learn more about the founding of the Satyagraha/Passive Resistance Movement in Johannesburg.

8:20pm: Guests gather back in the Scatterlings Restaurant for the story of Pan-African migration and an introduction to the main courses.

8:40pm

Pan-African inspired main courses served in the Zwipi Underground

1<sup>st</sup> Main: Zimbabwean Sadza with Chemolia and Tomato Sheba

(Drinks taster: gin with tonic, soda, strawberry and basil).

2<sup>nd</sup> Main: Mozambican Carapau/Mackerel Fish with tomato, onion and peppers

(Drinks taster: Tipo Tinto with ginger ale).

Guests gather in the Main Vault Room for storytelling

Chef Princess Bulelwa Mbonambi elaborates on the menu and ingredients

Introductory story to the desserts (Mediterranean/Middle Eastern Migrants)

The story of the United Safety Deposit vault, Somerset House and the Thunder Walker project, including the Thunder Walker Poem

Guests linger to enjoy the space and more drinks.
