The bespoke Joburg tour-guiding operation, JoburgPlaces, is also famous for its storytelling dinners, hosted at its Zwipi Underground at the Thunder Walker on Gandhi Square. Storytelling dinners are available on Friday and Saturday evenings. Each evening is limited to a total of 40 guests, meaning booking with prepayment is essential.

Storytelling is presented by Charlie Moyo while the food is prepared by the excellent Thunder Walker culinary team. Guests are seated at separate tables in Zwipi Underground for dinner as per bookings, but storytelling takes place collectively in different spaces of the Thunder Walker building.

Themes alternate between the Migrant Cuisine Storytelling Dinner and the Secret Underground Storytelling Dinner. The migrant cuisine experience involves the history and stories of the migrant communities of our city and their foods. It is a casual eating experience with six migrant-inspired dishes, appealing to the adventurous foodie.

The Secret Underground Storytelling Dinner involves a more formal, three-course dinner with exceptional Global-Afro fusion cuisine and storytelling focusing on the history and development of Johannesburg, appealing to those who appreciate gastronomic excellence.

Both storytelling dinners culminate in a session in the main vault room of the Zwipi Underground where guests get to hear the history of the Thunder Walker building (built in 1904 as Somerset House) and the many mysteries of this erstwhile bank and vault.

- While storytelling dinners are hosted for public bookings on Friday and Saturday nights, we are available for private group bookings throughout the week, but a minimum spend of R12 500 is required in order to open the restaurant for a private booking. 

Presented by JoburgPlaces at its Thunder Walker venue on Gandhi Square. Storytelling in the Scatterlings Arcade, dinner in the Zwipi Underground.

Typical schedule:

6:30pm: Guests arrive and mingle at the bar in the Zwipi Underground

7:00pm: Guests gather in the Scatterlings Arcade for the introductory story: the six phases of Johannesburg (each of which brought a new wave of migrants).

7:40pm: Two Asian-inspired starters served in the Zwipi Underground

7:50pm: Storytelling: Johannesburg's Asian communities during the Gold Rush and later (Cape Malay, Indian and Chinese).

8:10pm: Guests walk outside to view the Gandhi sculpture and learn more about the founding of the Satyagraha/Passive Resistance Movement in Johannesburg.

8:20pm: Guests gather back in the Zwipi Underground for the story of Pan-African migration and an introduction to the main courses.

8:40pm: Two Pan-African mains

9:15pm: Guests gather in the Main Vault Room for storytelling (Chef Princess Bulelwa Mbonambi elaborates on the menu and ingredients)

9:30pm: The story of the United Safety Deposit vault, Somerset House and the Thunder Walker project, including the Thunder Walker Poem

10:00pm: Two desserts are served

Guests are also welcomed to arrive earlier and enjoy drinks ahead of the dinner and to stay after to linger for more drinks. All drinks (except the included drinks taster) for guest's own account on the night.

MENU FOR THE MIGRANT CUISINE STORYTELLING DINNER

STARTERS

Cape Malay-inspired butternut soup with turmeric, paprika, ginger and coconut milk,
served in a coconut shell (vegan)
with a glass of masala tea & sauvignon blanc spritzer

Chinese-inspired beef dumpling with beef, ginger and soil, served with Asian greens and broth
(ask for a vegetarian alternative when booking if required)

MAINS

Zimbabwean-inspired sadza (pap) sandwich, served with chemolia and tomato sheba (vegan)

Mozambican-inspired carapau (mackerel fish), served with a tropical salad
(ask for a vegan aubergine alternative when booking if required)

DESSERT


Indian-Ethiopian-inspired Mango lassi served in a pineapple shell (vegetarian – contains yoghurt).

Mediterranean-inspired baklava with seeds instead of nuts, served with fresh fruits (vegetarian).

7:00pm: Guests arrive and mingle at the bar in the Zwipi Underground

7:30pm: Guests gather in the Scatterlings Arcade for the introductory story: the six phases of Johannesburg

8:00pm Starters served in the Zwipi Underground

8:15pm: Guests gather in the Scatterlings Arcade for storytelling: history of historic Somerset House, now the Thunder Walker

8:25pm: Guests walk outside to view the Gandhi sculpture and learn more about the founding of the Satyagraha/Passive Resistance Movement in Johannesburg.

8:35pm: Guests gather back in the Zwipi Underground for drinks orders at the bar.

8:50pm: Main courses served in the Zwipi Underground

9:30pm: Guests gather in the Main Vault Room for storytelling - chef Princess Bulelwa Mbonambi elaborates on the menu and ingredients

9:40pm: The story of the United Safety Deposit vault, Somerset House and the Thunder Walker project, including the Thunder Walker Poem

10pm: Dessert is served in the Zwipi Underground

HOW TO BOOK

Pre-booking and pre-payment are essential.

We will send you the total cost together with our banking details. A place on a storytelling dinner is only confirmed upon receipt of proof of payment.

For international clients who do not have a local bank account and cannot make a local transfer, we will send a Paypal request (10% surcharge to cover Paypal commission and international bank transfer charges), you can then follow the links and pay by foreign credit card.

We will send you an invoice for your records once we have received proof of payment.

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

Note that a booking is only secured once we have received proof of payment. Also note our terms and conditions, including our booking and refund policy:

1. A booking that is not followed by proof of payment within 48-hours will automatically be deemed cancelled.
2. Any already-paid cancellation will incur a 20% admin charge.
3. No cancellations or postponements will be accepted within 21 days of the actual booking date and no such refunds will be made.
4. Should a guest want to postpone a booking more than 21 days ahead of the original booking date, this will be done with pleasure and at no surcharge.
5. Participation in JoburgPlaces tours, dinners and experiences is voluntary and at the full risk of the customer. JoburgPlaces and Anchorco (Pty) Ltd as well as its venues (Scatterlings Arcade, Zwipi Underground and Town Square Banqueting Hall – all at the Thunder Walker) and its guides conducting tours, do not accept any liability for any harm, injury or death that may incur because of a guest participating in any tour, dinner or experience staged by JoburgPlaces.
6. All tours and storytelling dinner must be pre-booked and pre-paid. We do not accept any walk ins and no booking is secured or confirmed without paying first.

PAYMENT for drinks at Zwipi Underground

Note that Zwipi Underground only accepts bookings and do not accept any walk-ins, nor does it serve ala carte. Zwipi does not accept cash payments on site and do not hold cash on site. All food bookings are paid in advance and drinks can be settled on site by bank card.

NO CHILDREN UNDER 12

Note that we do not accept bookings for children under 12-years old on any storytelling dinners.

CORKAGE POLICY

Zwipi Underground has an extensive bar and we are confident that we will be able to serve you a variety of drinks to your satisfaction and enjoyment. We do not allow customers to bring any bubbly and if you want a special champagne or bubbly please arrange with us ahead of time.

We do allow customers to bring their own wine on the following condition. For each bottle of wine, you bring in, bring an extra bottle of the same wine and vintage which you will donate to Zwipi Underground as the corkage. These wines go into our wine cellar collection and be available for resale by Zwipi Underground. Alternatively, you can pay a corkage of R90 per bottle on site.

DIRECTIONS

All JoburgPlaces storytelling dinners take place at the Zwipi Underground at the Thunder Walker on Gandhi Square. Find our entrance on the square, right next to the Gandhi sculpture, between Sanlam and Hollard Insurance.

Note that casual parking is NOT AVAILABLE. If you are going to arrive by car and require parking it is essential that you send us your car number plate and arrange this with us so that we can book parking for you.

If you come by metered taxi, Uber or Taxify/Bolt simply get out at Nando's in Rissik Street, next to Gandhi Square. Walk onto the square past Pizza Hut towards the Gandhi Sculpture. Find our entrance next to the Gandhi sculpture, between Sanlam and Hollard Insurance.

If you come by Rea Vaya bus, get out at the Library Gardens station and walk towards Rissik Street and then Gandhi Square.

If you come by Gautrain **bus** from Park Station, get out at the third stop in Marshall Street. Walk east in Marshall until you get Rissik Street, turn left in Rissik Street and Gandhi Square is one block up on the right.

IMPORTANT:

Do **NOT** walk from Park Station to Gandhi Square or from Maboneng to Gandhi Square, there are unfortunately still some street blocks in the city that are problematic and not safe to walk past.

Do **NOT** try to call an Uber or Taxify/Bolt from Park Station. There is no parking for these services at Park Station and as they are at war with the Metered Cabs you can get yourself easily into an ugly situation by calling Uber or Taxify from the station. If you get to Park Station by Gautrain, take the escalators up immediately in front of the turnstiles where you exit the station. At the top of the escalators you will see the metered cabs parked. Take a metered cab from there to Gandhi Square (expect to pay around R70 or R80 for the cab).

IF YOU COME BY CAR:

NOTE THE M2 ELEVATED HIGHWAY HAS BEEN REOPENED SO IT IS REALLY EASY TO GET TO US!

From the north, take the M1 South and then the M2 East.

Take the Rissik Street offramp.

Once in Rissik Street, cross 4 traffic lights (in close succession).

The 4th traffic light is at Gandhi Square with the square on your right. Cross this traffic light and then just BEFORE Nando's turn right onto the paving of the square (there is an open white boom gate) and drive onto the paving past Pizza Hut until you see the entrance to the underground parking right next to our building and close to the Gandhi sculpture. The parking entrance is between Pizza Hut and Sanlam.

NOTE THAT YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARK HERE IF YOU HAVE NOT PRE-BOOKED PARKING WITH US.
