(seatings at 1pm, 2pm 3pm, 7pm and 8pm)

Johannesburg is known for its incredible diversity of cuisine. As a city of migrants, Joburg boasts food from all over the world, representing the diversity of nations in one location. Joburg's inner-city is especially known for its Pan-African cuisine and for the intrepid traveler it would not be impossible to find cuisines from over 50 African countries in the streets of the city.

Every Friday and Saturday, JoburgPlaces offers guests the opportunity to lunch or dine at its Thunder Walker venue, a refurbished bank building dating to 1904, just off Gandhi Square. Here guests can enjoy lunch in the beautiful Scatterlings Arcade or dinner in the hidden Zwipi Underground (what once was the bank vault).

This set-menu foodie experience is served as platters in the centre of the table for a group to share with an abundance of taste on offer. Guests can choose items from the platters and serve these into their own plates to enjoy. The menu is designed as a substantial meal a group to share at R350 per person.

MENU

First course

Scatterlings Sangria Spritzer

Masala chai and turmeric tea with sauvignon blanc, soda & lemonade

+ Greek mezze platter

Olives, feta wrapped in spinach, cucumbers, red onions, cherry tomatoes, pita, tatziki and humus
(large platter)

Second course

Egyptian mahshi

Savoury rice and stuffed vegetables in mixed pepper with a curry tomato sauce

+ Mozambican matapa

Casava/collard greens, tahini and prawn stew, served with rice (nut free)

+ Nigerian peppered tilapia

Richly seasoned whole tilapia served with a marinated salad

Third course

Ethiopian tibs

Seasoned seared fillet cubes with a chili, onion and tomato pickle and roti

+ Chicken chow mein

Egg noodles, bokchoy, onions, leeks and chicken in soy sauce

+ SA chicken four ways

Chicken butter ball, chicken dumpling, chicken drumstick and optional chicken feet
(4 chicken items)

Fourth course

Nut-free baklava + Fig and rosemary truffles

** Vegan and vegetarian alternatives can be arranged when booking*

HOW TO BOOK

Pre-booking and pre-payment are essential.

We will send you the total cost together with our banking details. A booking is confirmed upon receipt of proof of payment.

For international clients who do not have a local bank account, payment can be arranged to be done by foreign credit card on site.

We will send you an invoice for your records once we have received proof of payment.

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

Note that a booking is only secured once we have received proof of payment. Also note our terms and conditions, including our booking and refund policy:

1. A booking that is not followed by proof of payment within 48-hours will automatically be deemed cancelled.
2. Any already-paid cancellation will incur a 20% admin charge.
3. No cancellations or postponements will be accepted within 21 days of the actual booking date and no such refunds will be made.
4. Should a guest want to postpone a booking more than 21 days ahead of the original booking date, this will be done with pleasure and at no surcharge.
5. Participation in JoburgPlaces tours, dinners and experiences is voluntary and at the full risk of the customer. JoburgPlaces and Anchorco (Pty) Ltd as well as its venues (Scatterlings Arcade, Zwipi Underground and Town Square Banqueting Hall – all at the Thunder Walker) and its guides conducting tours, do not accept any liability for any harm, injury or death that may incur because of a guest participating in any tour, dinner or experience staged by JoburgPlaces.

PAYMENT for drinks at Thunder Walker

Note that the Thunder Walker's Scatterlings Arcade and Zwipi Underground do not accept cash payments on site and do not hold cash on site. All food bookings are paid in advance and drinks can be settled on site by bank card.

NO CHILDREN UNDER 12

Note that we do not accept bookings for children under 12-years old in Zwipi Underground. Children are welcome for lunch in the Scatterlings Arcade.

CORKAGE POLICY

Thunder Walker has an extensive bar and we are confident that we will be able to serve you a variety of drinks to your satisfaction and enjoyment. We do not allow customers to bring any bubbly and if you want a special champagne or bubbly please arrange with us ahead of time.

We do allow customers to bring their own wine on the following condition. For each bottle of wine, you bring in, bring an extra bottle of the same wine and vintage which you will donate to Thunder Walker as the corkage. These wines go into our wine cellar collection and be available for resale. Alternatively, you can pay a corkage of R90 per bottle on site.

DIRECTIONS

All Meze Migrant Feasts takes place at the Thunder Walker. Either in the Scatterlings Arcade (lunch) or the Zwipi Underground (dinner) Find our entrance on Gandhi Square, right next to the Gandhi sculpture, between Sanlam and Hollard Insurance. We also have an entrance in Fox Street, between Metropolitan and Bayport. This address is 110 Fox Street.

Note that casual parking is NOT AVAILABLE. If you are going to arrive by car and require parking it is essential that you send us your car number plate and arrange this with us so that we can book parking for you.

If you come by metered taxi, Uber or Taxify/Bolt simply get out at Nando's in Rissik Street, next to Gandhi Square. Walk onto the square past Pizza Hut towards the Gandhi Sculpture. Find our entrance next to the Gandhi sculpture, between Sanlam and Hollard Insurance.

If you come by Rea Vaya bus, get out at the Library Gardens station and walk towards Rissik Street and then Gandhi Square.

If you come by Gautrain **bus** from Park Station, get out at the third stop in Marshall Street. Walk east in Marshall until you get Rissik Street, turn left in Rissik Street and Gandhi Square is one block up on the right.

IMPORTANT:

Do **NOT** walk from Park Station to Gandhi Square or from Maboneng to Gandhi Square, there are unfortunately still some street blocks in the city that are problematic and not safe to walk past.

Do **NOT** try to call an Uber or Taxify/Bolt from Park Station. There is no parking for these services at Park Station and as they are at war with the Metered Cabs you can get yourself easily into an ugly situation by calling Uber or Taxify from the station. If you get to Park Station by Gautrain, take the escalators up immediately in front of the turnstiles where you exit the station. At the top of the escalators you will see the metered cabs parked. Take a metered cab from there to Gandhi Square (expect to pay around R70 or R80 for the cab).

IF YOU COME BY CAR:

NOTE THE M2 ELEVATED HIGHWAY HAS BEEN REOPENED SO IT IS REALLY EASY TO GET TO US!

From the north, take the M1 South and then the M2 East.
Take the Rissik Street offramp.
Once in Rissik Street, cross 4 traffic lights (in close succession).

The 4th traffic light is at Gandhi Square with the square on your right. Cross this traffic light and then just BEFORE Nando's turn right onto the paving of the square (there is an open white boom gate) and drive onto the paving past Pizza Hut until you see the entrance to the underground parking right next to our building and close to the Gandhi sculpture. The parking entrance is between Pizza Hut and Sanlam.

NOTE THAT YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARK HERE IF YOU HAVE NOT PRE-BOOKED PARKING WITH US.
